Camper Dress Code

Each Camper needs to bring a pair of tennis shoes. Old ones are recommended.

No extreme form of personal experience will be allowed to interfere with the camping experience for other campers.

INAPPROPRIATE items include:

See-through or mesh shirts, blouses, or pants

Tank Tops, tube tops, or halter tops which show the midriff, backs, shoulders, sides, and navel, or allow undergarments to show.

NO spaghetti straps of any kind are permitted (unless at the Dean's discretion).

Biker shorts, track shorts, gym shorts, and short-shorts. All shorts and skirts must be not more than six (6) inches above the knee.

Clothing with any objectionable language, slogans, or pictures.

Clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, or tobacco

Sagging pants or shorts are not allowed. Pants are to be pulled up or something will be provided to hold pants up.

Pants / shorts, shirts may not have cuts, slits, holes, slashes, or expose skin in any manner.

No skinny pants or jeans.

No sports or cheerleading uniforms

Hats, caps, bandannas, head coverings, and sunglasses, while appropriate in the sun, are NOT appropriate for worship services.
