No extreme forms of personal expression that interfere with the camping experience for other campers.

Inappropriate items include:

Clothing with any objectionable language, slogans, pictures, that promote drugs, alcohol, or tobacco

See-through clothing, crop tops, tube tops, halter tops, or spaghetti straps

Shorts, skirts, and dresses should be an appropriate length.

Pants are to be around your waist.

NO midriffs, navels, chest regions, or bottoms need to be shown or emphasized

NO excessive exposure of skin

Recommendation:

Each day will be filled with different activities such as water games, fishing, walking trails, volleyball, basketball, kick ball, painting, crafts, etc. Due to the use of paint, water, and the weather in general, each camper should have on older/everyday tennis shoes and clothing. **Nothing that can't get a little dirty.** Do not bring expensive/irreplaceable clothing/shoes.

For water games, shirts and shorts are required.

Middle School campers do not need any sort of church attire. We are very relaxed at our evening service.

High School campers may bring casual church clothing and will be given a chance to freshen up before evening services if they prefer.

On Friday nights of both weeks the campers will be singing at the 7:00 service. A Ruggles Camp shirt will be provided. The camper will need a pair of appropriate length denim/khaki shorts/jeans.
