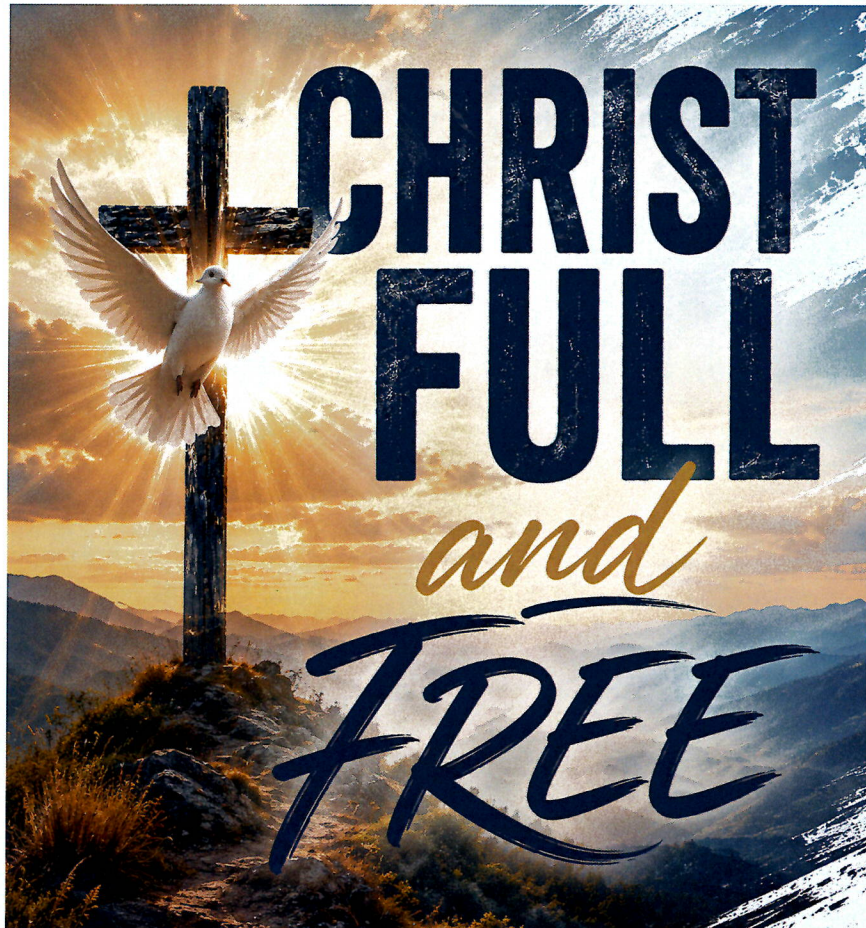


154th Ruggles Camp Meeting

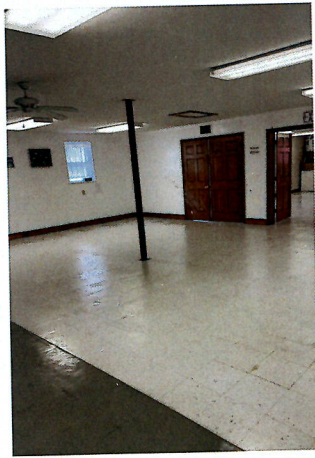
